Historic Clarks Hill Resort holds Reopening Ceremonies with GA Department of Community Affairs

(LINCOLNTON, GA) – The 60-year old Soap Creek Marina and Resort will officially reopen this Thursday at noon headlined by Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Georgia Rural Jobs Act (GARJA) Program Manager Holly Hunt, thanks to \$1 million in re-development funding through the Act.

The unique “Soap Creek Project” includes both restoration of the resort and a nearby factory for boat manufacturing and distribution by Apex Marine of St. Louis, Michigan. The Project is currently featured by DCA as a statewide model of rural job development in [County Government Magazine](#).
